#### **Response to 'Atmosphere'**

"In my artistic practice, the concept of atmosphere transcends the literal to embrace the ethereal. My process is driven by intuition and spontaneity, which includes pouring, dripping, and gentle manipulation of inks and pigments on the canvas which evoke a sense of tranquillity, reminiscent of the quietude found in natural surroundings and mirroring the intangible essence of the unseen world which envelops us. Through deliberate editing, akin to the refining forces in nature, these compositions breathe with the spaciousness, natural beauty, and simplicity inherent in our surroundings"



"Whether it's as a gas or an ambience, the word atmosphere encompasses something dynamic and enveloping. As an ambience it engages all our senses and evokes an emotional response. 'Revival' captures an ethereal interplay of colour, positive and negative space and organic shapes that mirror the protective bubble of atmosphere that blankets our blue planet. 'Interwoven is a painted and stitched work that is intentionally abstract, leaving it to the viewer to interpret whether this is a literal landscape, seascape or the multiple layers of the atmosphere that envelop and protect our earth.

#### **Response to 'Atmosphere'**

"Atmosphere in a pictorial sense is illusionary. My interpretation of this theme was to create a pervading sense of emotion with colour, rhythm, tone and an all-over treatment of brush marks across the surface of the canvas. I wanted to capture ephemeral moments of light in subtle transitions of tone. I've created illusionary landscapes of light in two colours: olive green and pyrrole orange. Creating atmosphere in a painting for me is to evoke a mood, a mesmerising feeling through colour, an illusion or sensory experience by abstraction, without the literal depiction of an exact subject".


